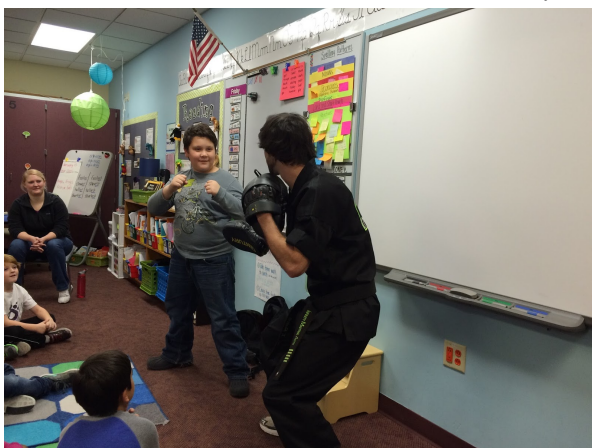


### Ask Me

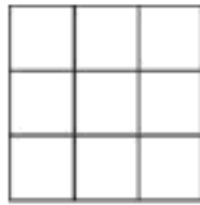

## Math at a Glance

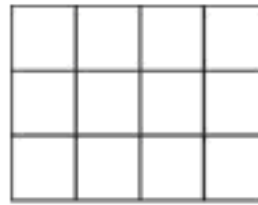
